

Seal of Biliteracy for the State of Florida

In 2016, the Florida Legislature passed a law (1003.432) that provides for students to earn a "Seal of Biliteracy" upon graduation from high school if they meet the following criteria. Students who meet the criteria based on credits earned in high school or tests for which the district already collects data (AP, IB, AICE) will automatically be identified.

Criteria to earn a GOLD Seal of Biliteracy

I earned a 4 or higher on the English Language Arts/Florida State Assessment.

I qualify because of ONE (1) of the 2 options below:

1. I earned 4 high school credits in one foreign language with a 3.0/4.0 GPA in the language classes.
2. I received a qualifying score on a test (see list below) and submitted my official scores to Brevard Public Schools

Criteria to earn a SILVER Seal of Biliteracy

I earned a 3 on the English Language Arts/Florida State Assessment.

I qualify because of ONE (1) of the 2 options below:

1. I earned 4 high school credits in one foreign language with a 3.0/4.0 GPA in the language classes.
2. I received a qualifying score on a test (see list below) and submitted my official scores to Brevard Public Schools
